**FINAL DIAGNOSIS:**  
**SPECIMEN A: CERVICAL PUNCH BIOPSY AT 12 O'CLOCK**  
High-grade squamous intraepithelial lesion, HSIL, CIN II (of III) arising in a background of low-grade squamous intraepithelial lesion, LSIL, CIN I (of III). Transformation zone present.

**SPECIMEN B: ENDOCERVICAL CURETTINGS**  
Unremarkable ectocervical (squamous) mucosa and endocervical glandular tissue.  
No squamous intraepithelial lesion.

**Gross Description:**

Received in formalin is a 0.4 x 0.3 x 0.2 cm aggregate of tan irregularly shaped soft tissue. Stained with eosin. Totally submitted. Sections: A1-1.  
Received in formalin is a 0.7 x 0.6 x 0.2 cm aggregate of brown/tan irregularly shaped soft tissue with mostly admixed mucus. Stained with eosin. Sections: B1:N. DW/ek
